

Full-scale starvation is setting in for the Gaza Strip's 2.2 million people. Even more catastrophic results will unfold should humanitarian assistance totally collapse in the southern parts of the Gaza Strip, as has happened in the north. A staggering 75% of the population has been displaced, some multiple times. Today 1.5 million people — children, adults, elderly, pregnant women, and the sick and injured — are currently crowded into Rafah. This area, which is the size of an airport, now has twice the population density of New York City
